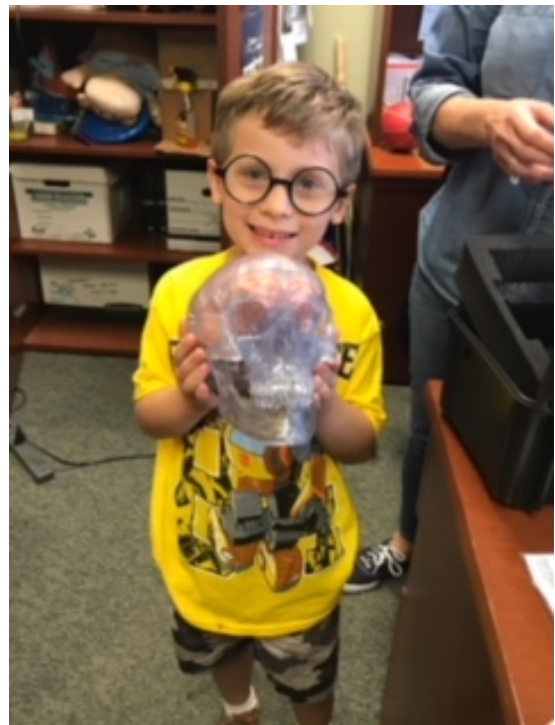

Laura has a background in Human Resources. She came from a family full of entrepreneurs, including her father and her grandfathers in Italy and Spain. Laura felt a strong call to serve others which is why Human Resources was her chosen field. As a coach, Laura feels that it is her mission to create "consciousness and awareness" of the importance of finding emotional support during the divorce process. This is not exactly a lesson that one would have in school. Dealing with a broken heart is not an easy process and help can be provided. Men and women going through a separation or divorce need a team in order to completely cover all of their needs: an attorney, a financial advisor and a therapist or coach to help the emotional aspect of this process.

As a successful woman in business, Laura described herself as a goal-oriented person who is persistent and creative. She also attributes her success to her ability to motivate even herself if she is faced with the unexpected. She doesn't give up. Laura is humble and able to recognize a need for help. She

has a team supporting her in many areas including marketing, social media, graphic designers, etc.

As far as Laura's favorite part of being a woman in her field, she notes that she serves mostly women (80%). She does work with men as well, but the majority of her clients are women. She has studied and research the mind and the behavior during the grieving process and has developed a great understanding of the female brain. Also, having been divorced herself twice, she can empathize and use her personal experience to connect.

Laura gives credit to an opportunity that she had where she lived in Israel and participated in a course with Tim Kelley. Tim is a Global Mentor who helps people to find their purpose in life. Laura's direction from Tim was clear: "heal broken hearts." This was already what Laura loved to do and felt it was her contribution to the world to bring light to the dark and joy instead of sadness.



As far as adversity, Laura describes the fact that she has lived in many places over the years and has built up contacts in such other places. Her family has relocated to Florida and she has been here approximately one year. Her biggest stressor with this is her ability to find clients here in Florida being a newcomer to the area.

Laura believes that her being a woman is a big advantage as a divorce coach as most of her clientele are also women. She feels that women can sometimes understand another woman in pain greater than a male counterpart. She is also serving in both English and Spanish.
